OPPORTUNITY

A joint partnership between the Indigenous Leadership Development Institute, Inc., and R.B Russell Vocational School has been established to train 25 Indigenous participants in a 36-week Indigenous Peoples Culinary Arts Program beginning on September 27, 2010 and ending on June 30, 2010. Students of the program will prepare themselves for employment readiness with an understanding of a safe and equitable work environment and have the skills necessary to successfully pursue a career in a chosen food industry field.

THE PROGRAM

The Indigenous Peoples Culinary Arts Program training will take place at **R B Russell Vocational School** located at **364 Dufferin Avenue**, Winnipeg, MB. The program is designed to graduate all participants with their **LEVEL 1 CULINARY ARTS APPRENTICESHIP**. Once the program is complete, the participants will be placed into organizations pertaining to the food industry. Included in the 36 week program, the following sessions and training will be provided: Food handler's certificate, WHIMIS, First Aid, restaurant and hospitality training in addition to their **LEVEL 1 CULINARY ARTS APPRENTICESHIP**.

Eligibility Requirements:

- * Aboriginal
- * Minimum of 19 years of age
- * Out of school in the past 6 months
- * Eligible for **FUNDING SUPPORT**
- * Minimum Grade 10
- * Receiving EI or EIA benefits
